



Minneola Collector Road Project Development & Environment Study

PROJECT KICK-OFF MEETING NOTICE

The City of Minneola has begun a Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study for the Minneola Collector Road. The project study area is bound by US 27 on the west, CR 561 on the north, Triple E Road on the east and CR 50 (Old 50) on the south.

The purpose of this study is to identify and evaluate alternatives and typical sections for the study area to meet capacity demands, to increase safety and to provide a continuous roadway network that meets the standards of the City and County. During the study process, the engineering, economic, social and environmental impacts of the proposed project will be analyzed. The results of this analysis will provide a basis for the selection of the recommended improvements to this study area including roads such as: Turkey Farms Road and North Grassy Lake.

Public Involvement is very important to the City and you are invited to get involved in this project.

The City of Minneola will be conducting a Public Kick-off Meeting on August 28, 2007, beginning at 6:00 p.m. at Minneola City Hall.

The Meeting will be an open-house format with a brief presentation beginning at 6:30 p.m. Project information and displays will be available. Representatives from the City, as well as other project team members, will be on hand to discuss the project and answer questions.
