



Minneola Collector Road Project Development & Environment Study

ALTERNATIVES PUBLIC MEETING

The City of Minneola is conducting a Project Development and Environment Study for a Minneola Collector Road (North Hancock Road Extension). The project study area is bound by US 27 on the west, CR 561 on the north, Triple E Road on the east and CR 50 (Old 50) on the south. The ongoing study is identifying and evaluating alternative improvements within the corridor, in order to meet future traffic demands and increase vehicular and pedestrian safety. The engineering, economic, social and environmental impacts of the proposed project are being analyzed. The results of this analysis will be presented at the Alternatives Public Meeting and will provide a basis for the selection of the recommended improvements to the study area.

You are invited to get involved in this project. The City of Minneola will be conducting an **Alternatives Public Meeting on February 28, 2008, beginning at 6:00 p.m.** at Minneola City Hall, 800 North US Hwy 27, Minneola, Fla. **The meeting will be an open-house format with a brief presentation beginning at 6:30 p.m.**

This meeting will provide opportunities for review of the alternatives developed for the study area. It is important to understand your concerns and comments regarding each of the alternatives. The City of Minneola, Lake County and its representatives will be available to discuss the alternatives and the impacts of each.
